Gloria Bachmann is a nationally and internationally recognized physician who has moved health care to the next level in many areas. At Rutgers Robert Wood Johnson Medical School, she is a Professor of Ob/Gyn & Medicine, the Associate Dean for Women's Health and the Co-director of the Women's Health Institute. At Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital -New Brunswick, she is the medical director of the PROUD Gender Center of NJ. For the NJ Reentry Commission, that serves previously incarcerated individuals, she is the medical director.

In the area of women's health, she is a respected clinician, a valued mentor, a prolific researcher, and a sought-after educator. She has a long history of being the principal and co-principal investigator on several clinical trials, including federally funded NIH protocols. Data derived from her participation in multiple research trials has added extensively to the literature and to many advances in women's health care. She is a graduate of Rutgers University and the Perlman School of Medicine, at the University of Pennsylvania. She also completed her Ob/Gyn residency training at the University of Pennsylvania.
